3 Yochanan 1

- 1:2 Beloved, my prayers are that you may prosper in all things and that you may have good health, just as you prosper in all personnal things.
- 1:3 I enjoyed myself so much when brothers came to visit me and gave testimony about you in the truth, as to say,in how you walk in the truth.
- 1:4 I get no greater pleasure than to hear that my children walk in the truth.
- 1:5 Beloved, you are walking faithfuly in all that you do for the brothers, and even more when they are strangers.
- 1:6 In the presence of the congregation, they have given testimony of your love, If they walk righteously before Yod-He-Wa-He, you have done well;
- 1:7 because they shared the name in love, without taking anything from the gentiles.
- 1:8 In the meantime, we should support such as these, those that labor in the truth.
- 1:9 I have written to the congregation; but Diotrefes, who has ambitions of being the leader among them, he does not respect us.
- 1:10 For this reason, If I go there,I will remember the works that he does and how he denies us with malicious words. Not satisfied with this, he rejects the brothers; even so the impedes those that want to join and rejects those from within the congregation.
- 1:11 Beloved, do not imitate the evil, but rather the good. The one that does good comes from Yod-He-Wa-He, but the one that does evil has not seen Yod-He-Wa-He.

- 1:12 Good testimony has been given about Demetrius in part from everyone and even so by the same truth. Equally we too give testimony, and you know our testimony is correct.
- 1:13 I had many things to write to you, but I don't want to do it through a quill and ink.
- 1:14 Better still, I hope to see you very soon, and personaly speak with you. Shalom be with you. Our friends send you salutations. Embrase all our friends, each one by name.
